Methodology

The Rising Stars Awards provides law firms and professional services firms in the region the recognition they deserve for the efforts of their up and coming practitioners in the legal profession. The event is split into individual categories and jurisdictional categories.

A Rising Stars Awards research team conducted a series of interviews –over the phone – with practitioners across multiple areas of law and jurisdictions advising of the accomplishments of key practitioners. The team also incorporated other research from within the group in order to further refine the results i.e. magazine survey results / directory analysis, etc.

A Rising Star is defined as an associate or of counsel (or a recently raised partner), with up to fifteen years professional experience, are under forty years old, and have been acting at a partner level.

How are winners decided?

The winning individuals and firms are decided by senior Euromoney Rising Stars Awards editorial staff following an extensive research process.

Winners are judged on their professional accomplishments, advocacy and influence within their specialism between 01 January to 31 December of the preceding year, as well as peer review and referee commentary.

The Rising Stars Awards will be recognising multiple individuals in each awards category.
